

@ The Piano Music Studio - COVID 19 Safety / Health Policy

Policy written on 5-29-2020

In order to protect everyone in the studio (and their families) and in compliance with Spokane Health District's Phase II Reopening Guidelines, the following policy is in effect as of 6-1-2020 for on-site lessons for "*@ The Piano*" Music Studio owned by Janet Hubbard.

Students (and any attending family members) must commit to the following reopening policies:

- Sanitizing/washing hands prior to music lesson
- Wearing a mask while in the piano studio
- Canceling lesson/session if you or a member of your household has any of the following COVID 19 symptoms:
 - Sore throat
 - Cough
 - Fever
 - Loss of taste/smell
 - Shortness of breath
- Waiting outside until invited into studio to allow for cleaning between lessons. Wipe down outdoor chairs with provided sanitizing clothes prior to using.
- Sign a waiver of consent form prior to attending in-person lessons (one per family).

Teacher (Janet Hubbard) will:

- Check temperature every morning
- Cancel lesson if any COVID 19 symptoms are present (fever, sore throat, cough, loss of taste/smell, or shortness of breath).
- Sanitize/wash hands prior to music lesson
- Wear a mask during lesson
- Sanitize common surfaces between lessons (including piano keyboard, door knobs, stairway hand rails, and bathroom sink)
- Demonstrate piano technique on a separate keyboard from student

NOTE: If any lessons are canceled for COVID 19 symptoms, make-up lessons will be provided, but may need to be done online instead of in person.
